## Online Safety



---

As it is coming up to half term your children may well be on devices more than usual. Here are a few tips to keep your children safe online:

---

- *Talk to your child about what they are doing online, keep up to date with what games and apps they are using.*
- ***Instagram, Snapchat, Twitter, Whatsapp etc:** Many of these sites have a minimum age limit of 13 (Whatsapp has a minimum age limit of 16). If this is something that you are letting your child use, then tight monitoring of their use on this is vital. We often find that children are not aware of some of the potential dangers when using these apps and sometimes they can respond inappropriately, not always behaving in the online world as they would in the real world.*
- ***PS4/5, X-Box Live etc** - Many games consoles come with the ability to play others online. Parents/carers should be aware of who their children are playing and communicating with. Always ensure your child knows how to block or report people online who send nasty or inappropriate messages or content. Encourage your child not to retaliate or reply.*
- *Make sure your child knows to tell a trusted adult if they see something online that makes them feel scared, worried or uncomfortable. If they don't feel that they can talk to someone*

that they know, then they can call Childline (0800 1111). The following link provides lots of information for parents, so please do have a look.
