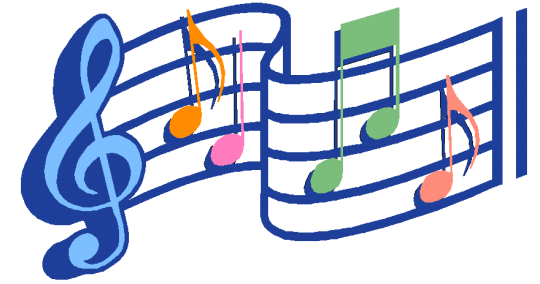




Playlist!
